This is the september 2014 statement which accompanies the accounts for the financial year 2013 to sep 2014, which accounts are produced both for Companies House and also for the Inland Revenue with regard to any Corporation Tax liability.

Belmont Publications publishes the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

In the last business year, sep 2013 to sep 2014, eight more titles have been produced - 'Kata Isaiah', a poetic version of the second half of Isaiah's prophecy; 'Gatherings', a series of letters written to various leaders of gatherings in the UK; 'A Serious Examination of the Westminster Confession'; 'Faith and Science'; 'The Testing of Pillars'; 'Crucified', from Galatians; 'Apokalupsis', the entire Book of the Revelation in poetic verse; and 'The Son - of man', being an examination of the nature of the coming into the world of Jesus Christ and a consideration of four ways in which his humanity is viewed in the Greek scriptures.

Ten more videos have been added to the website, each being recordings of lectures given locally in the Malvern-Upton area.

Belmont now offers to the public a list of twenty books, a series of twenty recordings and a variety of freely downloadable literature on the website.

Since the financial year ended, a further poetry book has been completed - the whole of the Epistle to the Hebrews, entitled '*en Huios*' with ten additional hymns and translation notes on over 50 important Greek words found in the epistle, many of which are unique, within scripture, to that epistle.
