

Director's Statement for 2015

The entire book of Hebrews was put into poetic verse, accurately, from the literal translation of the Greek. An in depth study was completed which covered many Hebrew words and their interconnected meanings in the book 'The Cherubim of Glory' which also covered an explanation of what is generally referred to as 'atonement'. This was the largest undertaking carried out within Belmont and the largest book so far - 60,000 words. Two topical and very necessary booklets were produced, 'The Queen's Bishop' and 'The Son, Everlasting'. And work began on the book of Job to produce a new translation which would not only be more clear than what is already available but which, being in poetic form, would be closer to the original Hebrew presentation. Job is the most ancient book of scripture and one of the most ancient documents on earth. This is the first time it has been rendered in poetic form in any language other than Hebrew - as far as is currently known. In the current period, the words of Job have been completed. It is hoped, in the will of the Lord, to go on to complete the entire book during the next reporting period. The whole poetic version should be about 850 verses.
