Statement as at 1st october 2013

Belmont Publications publishes the Gospel Of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

1. September 2011 to april 2013

A Profit and Loss Account and a Balance Sheet have been sent to the Inland Revenue. This consisted of a list of expenditures, a stocktake of books and the current cash in the bank. Belmont has no other assets or liabilities. No Corporation Tax is payable in the year to april 2013. Belmont does not own the copyright to any writing; copyright is retained by author, personally. Abbreviated accounts have been filed at Companies House in accord with proper requirements and Companies House has accepted these accounts. Belmont has no need, and no present requirement, to be audited.

Belmont was incorporated 28/09/2011 and the bank account dates from June 2012. The first book published was "The Beginning of the Gospel" and the first book launch was december 2012 at Lyttelton Well, Malvern.

Up to april 2013, three booklets of poetic verse were published - "Lamentations", "Song of Solomon" and "Selections from Isaiah". Five books were also published - "The Beginning of the Gospel", "Righteousness", "Redemption and Restoration", "The Glory of the Lord" and "The Everlasting Testament".

Books were taken to retail outlets and given on a Sale or Return basis.

2. April 2013 to september 2013

Four more books have been published - "The Burden of Sins", "Knowledge and Life", "Light and Life" and "The Songs of the Witnesses", the last being 500 verses of biblical verse for singing or poetic reading. Four tracts have been published - "Sent", "Tree of Life", "Unburdening" and "Shibboleth". In progress is "Kata Isaiah" which is intended to be about 650 poetic verses from Isaiah chapters 40 to 66.

Greetings Cards have also been provided to retail outlets as added value to the product range. All the artwork and production for these is done by Belmont.

3. Summary

In its first two years of existence, Belmont has published sixteen items containing about a quarter of a million words of prose and poetry. Belmont has also provided the public, free of charge, with a website which contains free items of literature, free access to many letters and free viewing of recorded lectures and talks. Many books have been sent out, free of charge, to groups and individuals in various parts of the UK.
